Year of Prayer

This year has been set aside by Pope Francis as a year of prayer in preparation for the Holy Year next year. Throughout Lent, there is an opportunity for us to look at this as a parish (poster to follow). Also, beginning in Lent, we will have the opportunity to spend some time with our Lord in Exposition before each Mass, and there will be a day of reflection offered during Lent on 'The Prodigal Son'. PRAYER VIGIL AT DERWENTSIDE IRC SUNDAY 4TH FEBRUARY 3.00PM.

A monthly prayer vigil has been held at the barrier to the Derwentside Immigration Removal Centre for over a year. The purpose is to pray for the women who are detained, to stand in solidarity with them and to witness by our presence that their detention is inhumane, unjust and incompatible with our faith, which calls us to recognise with compassion the dignity of each person.
